

Bagmati Province Youth Summit 2025 (PYS): Empowering Local Leadership

Goal

The goal of the Bagmati Province Youth Summit is to bridge the gap between provincial youth and the government, fostering a platform for policy advocacy, leadership development, and sustainable entrepreneurship. The 2025 summit focuses on localizing the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) at the grassroots level across all 13 districts of Bagmati Province.

Description



Organized in close collaboration with the Province Youth Council (PYC) and the Nepal Youth Council (NYC), Bagmati UNESCO Club plays a pivotal role as a strategic partner and organizer. The summit serves as the highest provincial assembly of youth leaders, bringing together representatives from diverse backgrounds to discuss issues ranging from digital governance to climate resilience. Bagmati UNESCO Club facilitates the integration of UNESCO's values into the summit's agenda, ensuring that cultural preservation and global citizenship education are at the forefront of the provincial youth movement.

Key Features of the 2025 Initiative:

- **Provincial Policy Dialogue:** Youth-led plenary sessions where participants engage directly with the Chief Minister and provincial ministers to discuss the "Bagmati Youth Vision 2030."
- **Leadership and Governance Workshops:** Intensive training modules on local governance structures, public speaking, and the role of youth in federalism.

- **Entrepreneurship and Innovation Hub:** A dedicated space for young innovators to pitch sustainable business ideas, with a focus on green energy and agritech, supported by Bagmati UNESCO Club's mentorship network.
- **Digital Literacy and Anti-Disinformation Tracks:** Workshops designed to equip youth with the tools to navigate digital platforms responsibly, mirroring the "Shaasan" initiative's objectives.
- **The 10-Point Declaration:** The drafting of a comprehensive recommendation document presented to the Bagmati Province Government, outlining youth demands for education reform and employment opportunities.

Outcome

The 2025 Bagmati Province Youth Summit achieved the following transformative results:

- **Direct Policy Influence:** Successful inclusion of youth-led recommendations into the provincial annual budget and planning cycle.
- **Network Expansion:** Established a robust network of over 500 youth leaders across the province, creating a sustainable ecosystem for local activism.
- **Skill Acquisition:** Participants reported a 40% increase in confidence regarding their understanding of provincial governance and policy drafting.
- **Strengthened Institutional Collaboration:** Solidified the partnership between Bagmati UNESCO Club and the Ministry of Social Development, ensuring long-term youth involvement in government programs.

- **Youth Delegates (Aged 16–30):** Students, activists, and young professionals representing the 13 districts of Bagmati Province.
- **Government Officials:** Provincial ministers, members of the provincial assembly, and local municipal leaders.
- **Social Entrepreneurs:** Individuals looking to scale impact-driven projects within the province.
